Leviticus 25:1,8-17 Ps 67:2-3,5,7-8 Matthew 14:1-12 Jesus tells us that the kingdom of God is like a buried treasure, a pearl purchased at all cost, and a net from which the bad catch of fish will be tossed away and the good catch will be valued.

In other words, our Christian lives are huge cache of valuables. lf our treasure chest has any worthless trash. the garbage needs to be tossed away to

make room for more valuables. Some of our treasures have only temporary, earthly value, and ultimately they will be worthless unless they're used for the kingdom of God.

The reading from Romans tells us that all things work together for the good of those who love God. As we purge our lives of false pearls and dead fish, we become more like our Lord. We become more useful to the kingdom of God. Even the bad things that happen to us, under the creative hand of our all-powerful, mercifully loving God, get put to good use as polishing cloths that brighten our pearls and bring out from us a better shine.


In the first reading, Solomon could have asked God for great wealth and he would have received it, but he asked for an understanding heart so that he'd have wisdom to rule the nation well. Even though he ruled imperfectly, his reputation as

the wisest king on earth spread throughout the known world and he accumulated great wealth.

This is meant to teach us that when we seek first the treasures of God's

kingdom, then we can safely use the treasures of earth. because God's wisdom guides in using us them for the benefit of his kingdom. The more we love

Christ and follow his ways, the easier it is to identify what's really valuable, separate out the junk that does not belong to God, and use everything else for his purposes.

Religious Education Registration Information for Parents/Guardians

By registering my child(ren) for our program of Religious Education for 2023/2024, I agree to the following:

- 1. I will see to it that my child(ren) attend Mass regularly on weekends and on Holy Days of Obligation.
- 2. I will observe the class attendance policy of not missing more than two (2) classes per year. If my child needs to be absent, I will inform the staff by email or phone.
- 3. I will have my child(ren) to class on time and prepared.
- 4. I will notify the staff in writing (either by email or note), in advance, if people other than parent/guardian will be transporting my child home from class.
- 5. I will observe parking lot etiquette. Students will be playing on the playground at times. You are not to go past the cones. If children are playing when I pick up, I must get them from a teacher. If they dismiss from the hall, I must come to the walkway and you will send them out to me. Children will NOT be allowed to go to a vehicle without an adult coming to get them.
- 6. Should discipline problems arise I will work with the director and Religious Education staff to solve them.
- 7. I will read all letters, memos and emails sent by the Religious Education director and staff regarding my child's Religious Education Program. I will inform the director of any changes in contact information, including email address changes.
- 8. I will provide the staff with required sacramental paperwork on time.

All students meet on Wednesday evenings
PreK - 5 will begin promptly at 5:30pm and end at 6:30pm
Jr High and High School Youth will meet from 6:30pm – 8:00pm
